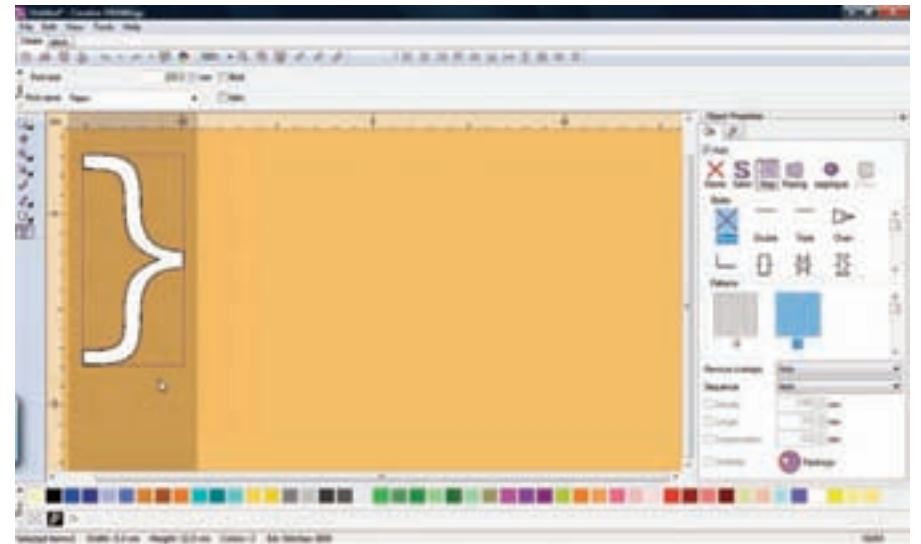




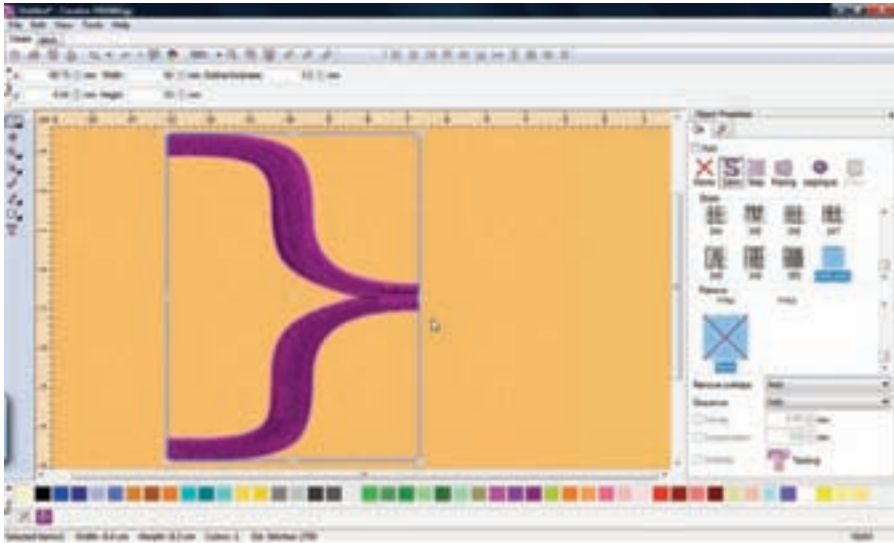
# In Bloom

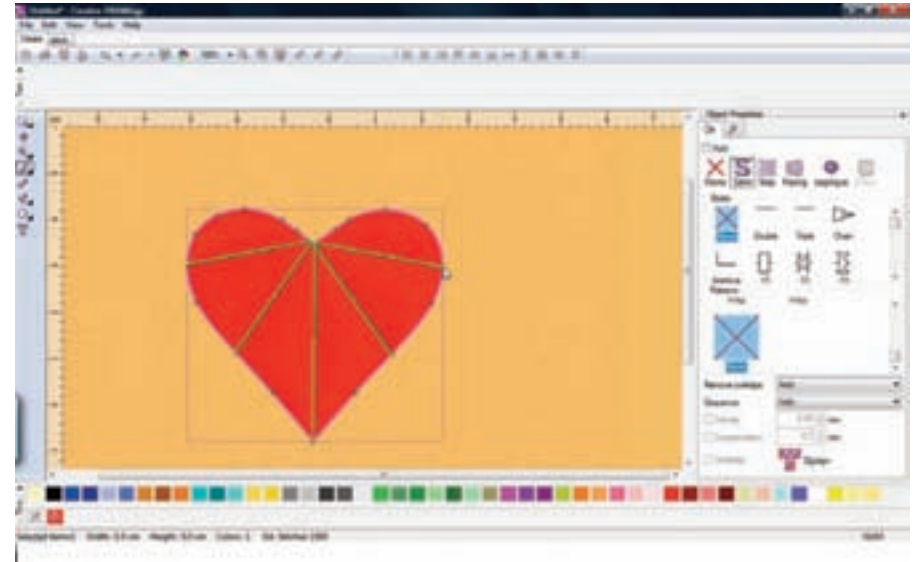
## Step 1



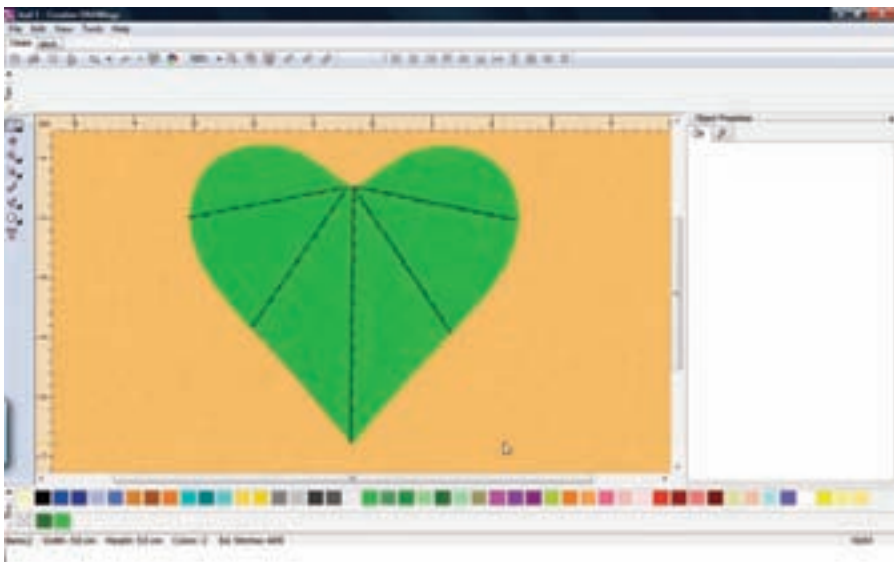
1. Choose a parenthesis symbol to create curve shape.



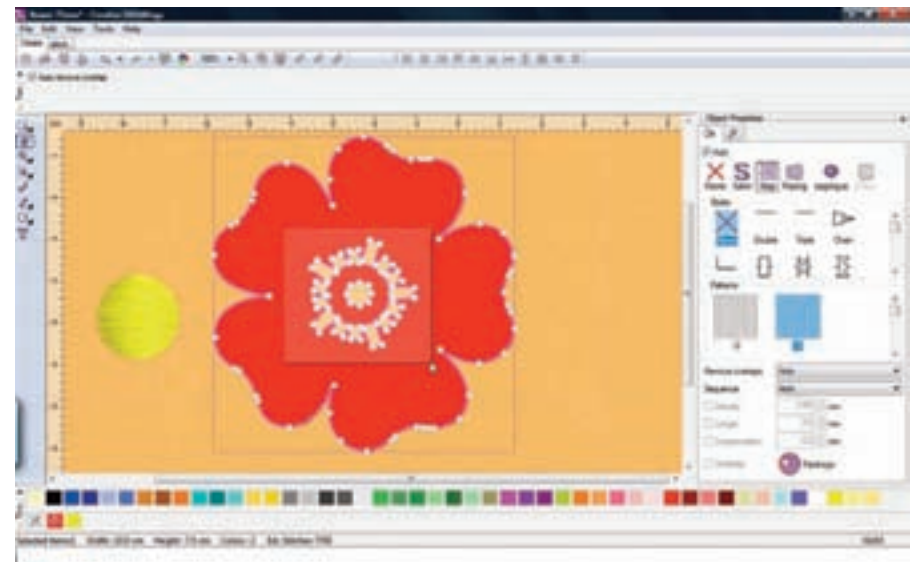
2. Choose a satin fill stitch that's 64 mm x 83 mm.



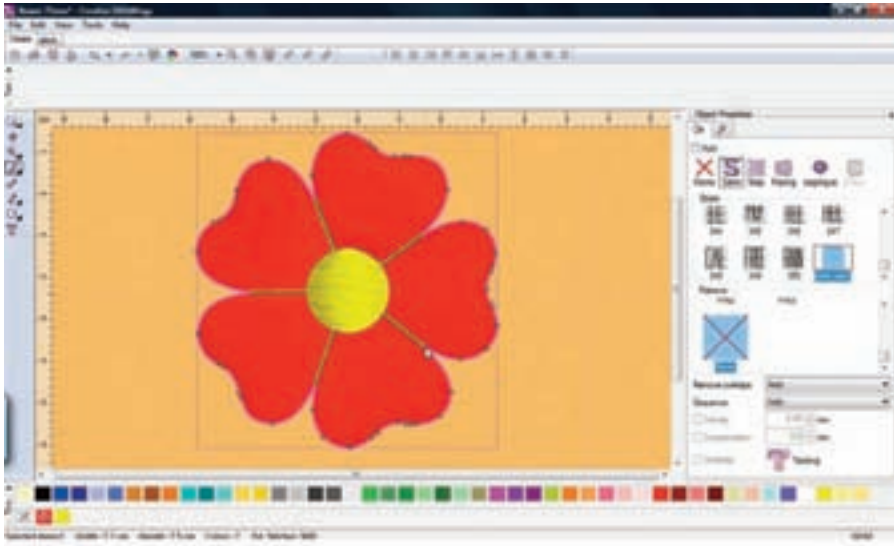
3. Divide heart shape.



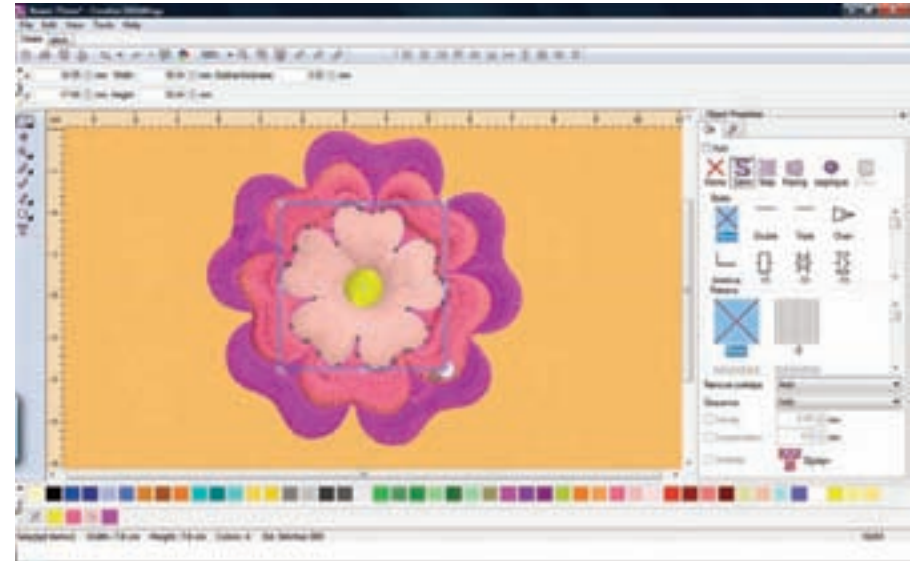
4. Make each segment a satin fill stitch.



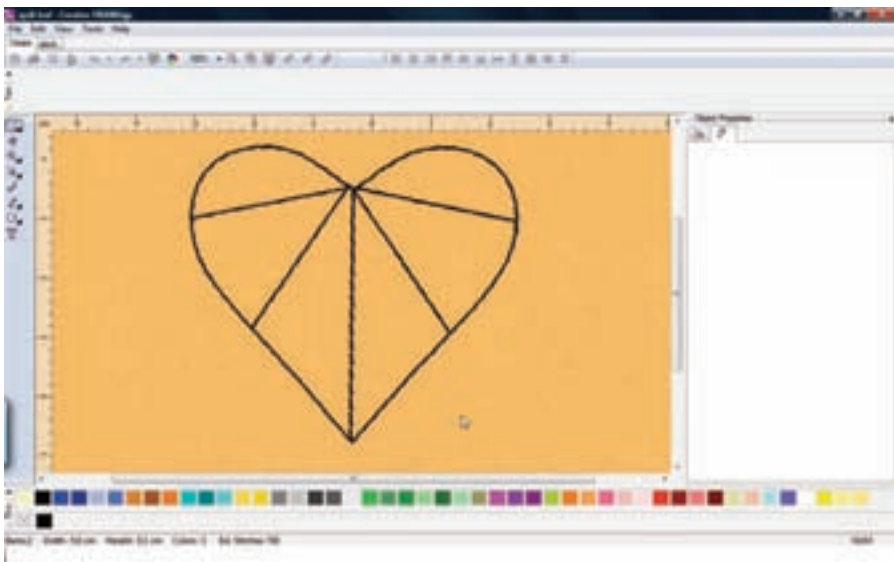
5. Simplify flower center.



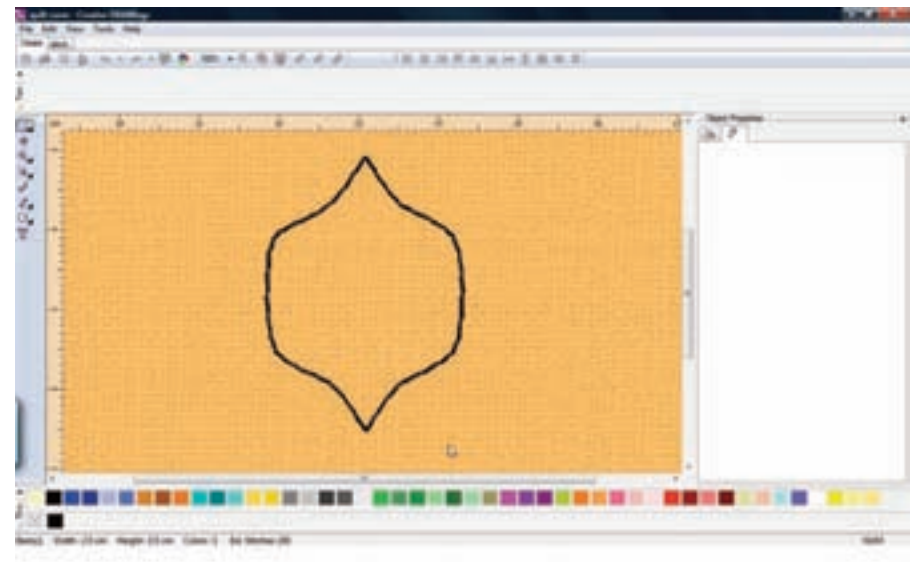
6. Divide petals and make satin fill.



7. Stack and rotate petals to create triple flower.

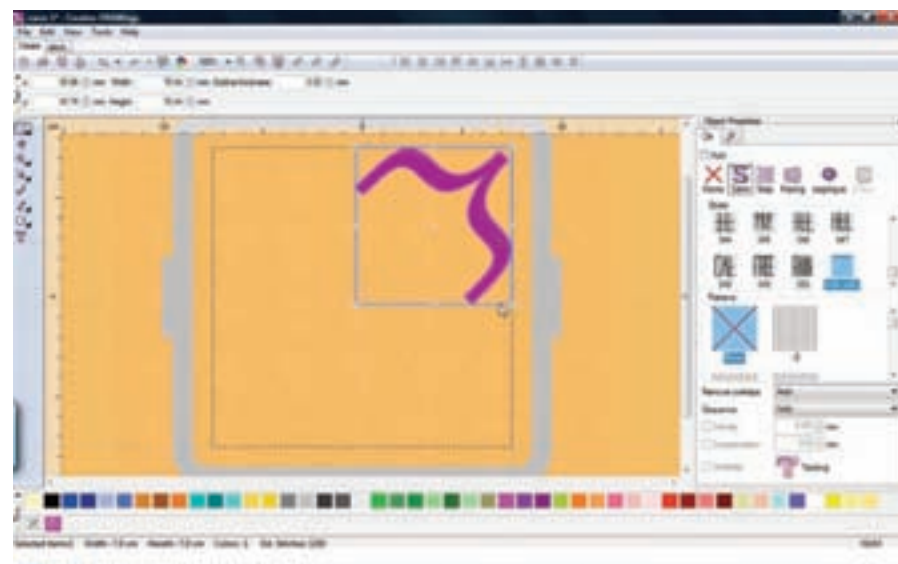


8. Quilting motif outline for heart shape.

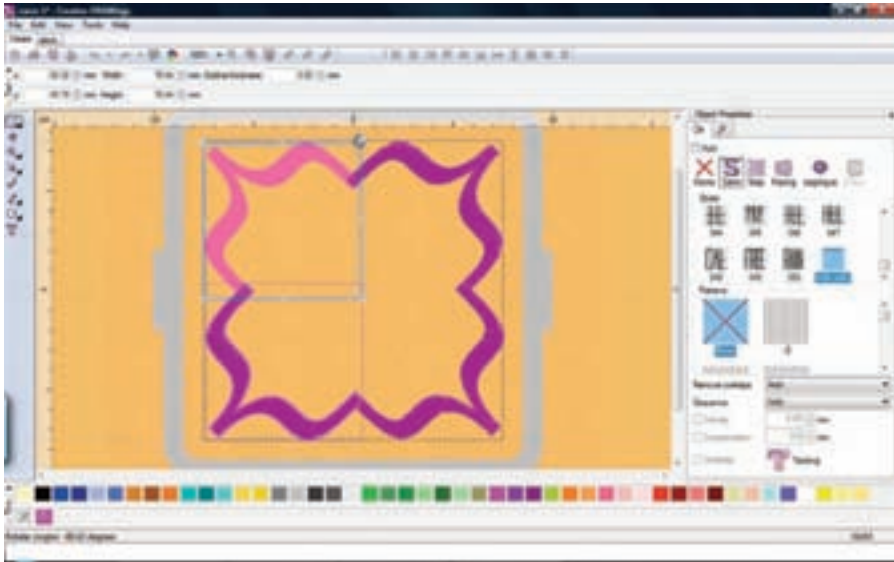


9. Mirror image curve shape to create closed quilt shape.

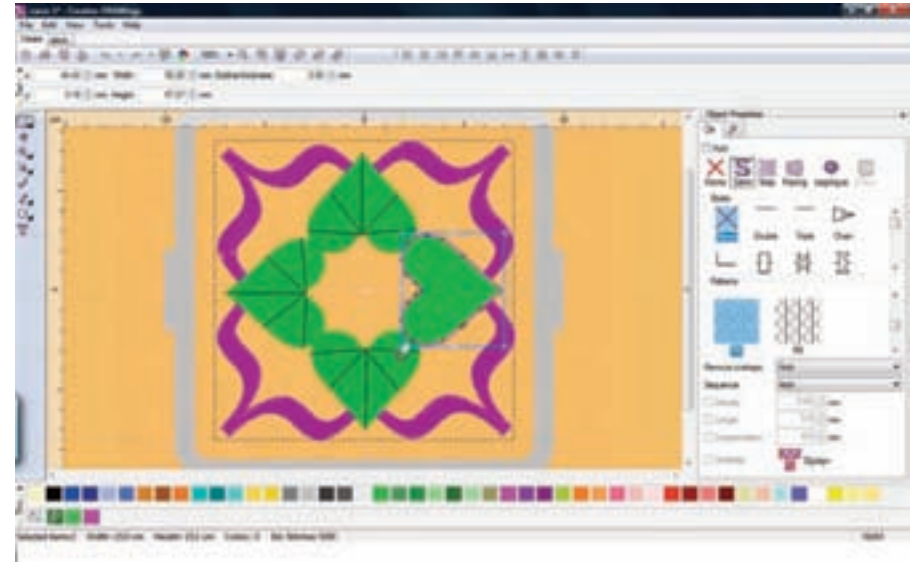
# Block One



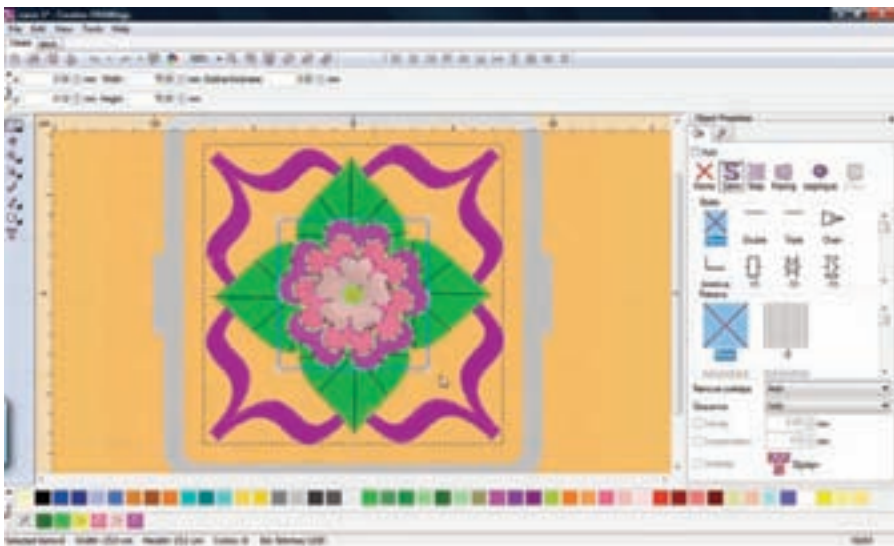
10. Open curve 1. Rotate 45° and position in upper right corner of square.



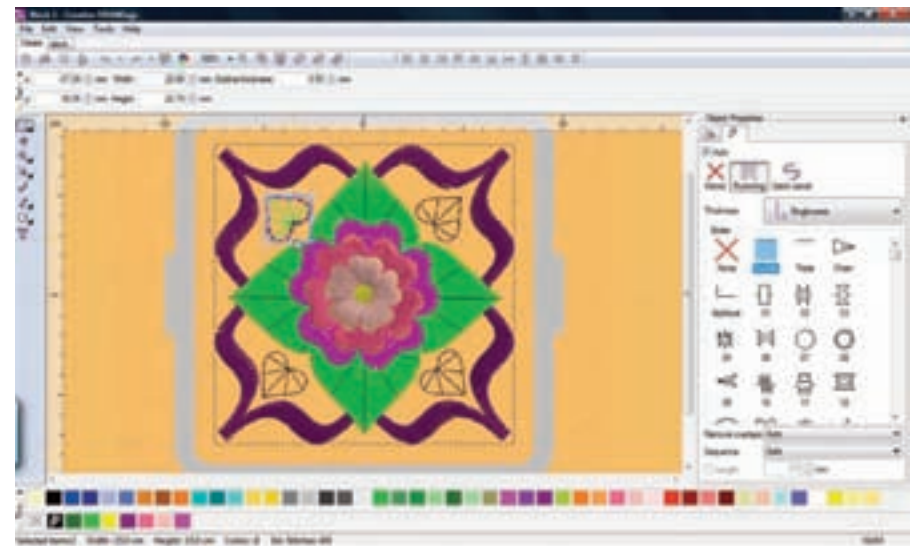
11. Position three more curves in each block corner.



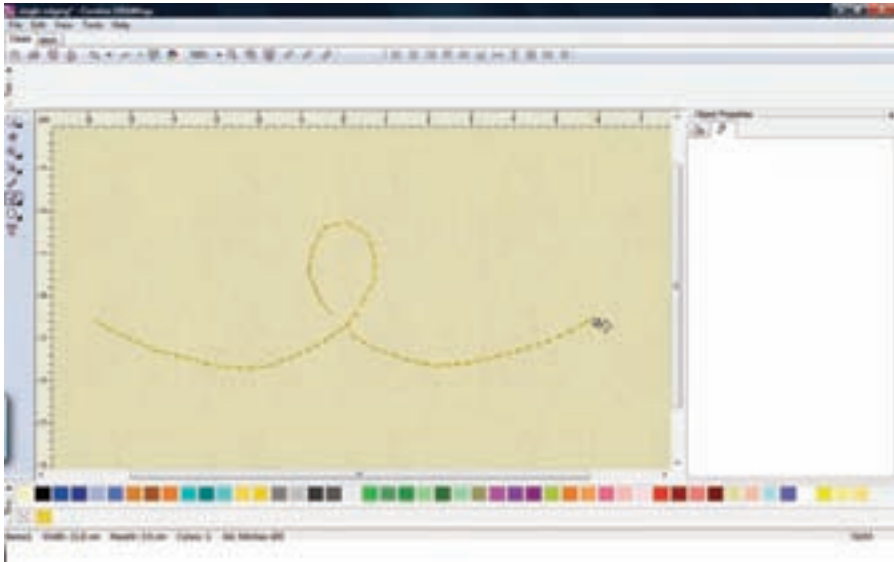
12. Add leaf 1. Center point between two curves. Copy and paste three more leaves around block.



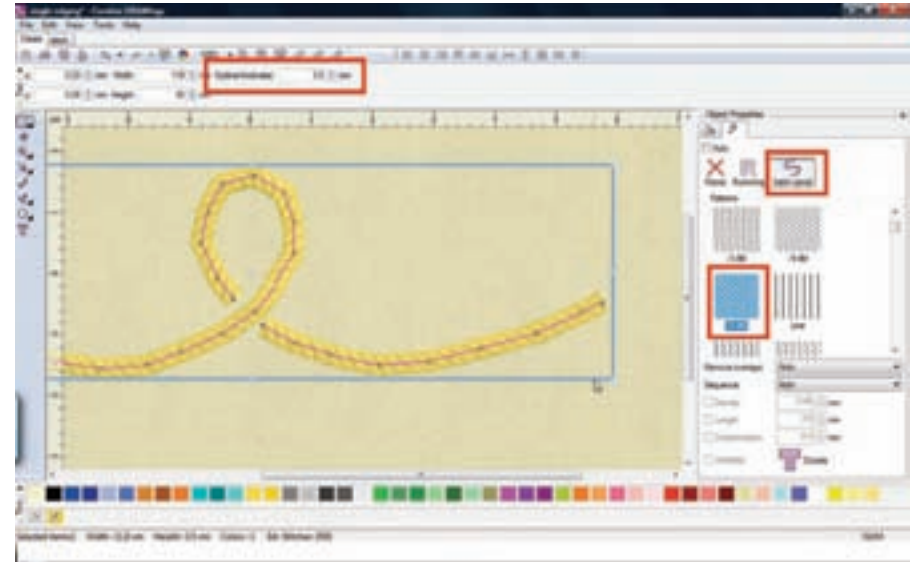
13. Add Triple Flower to block center.



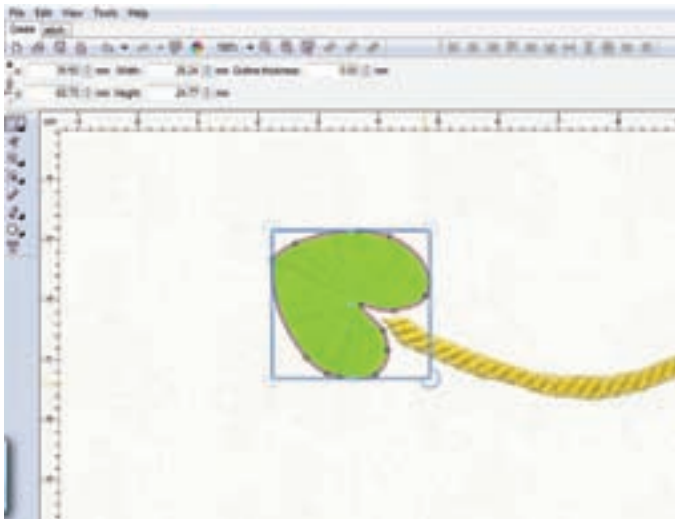
14. Add quilt motifs to block.



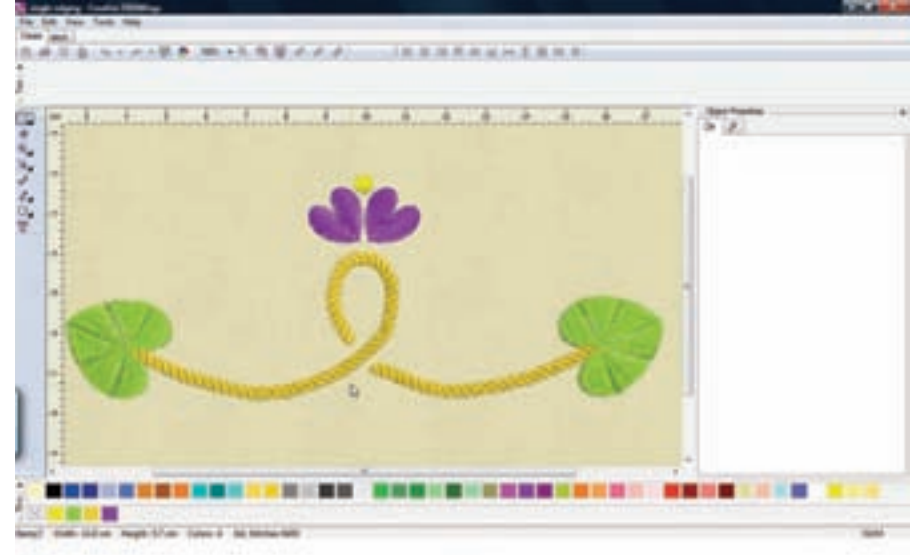
15. Draw a loop.



16. Patterned Satin Column Fill



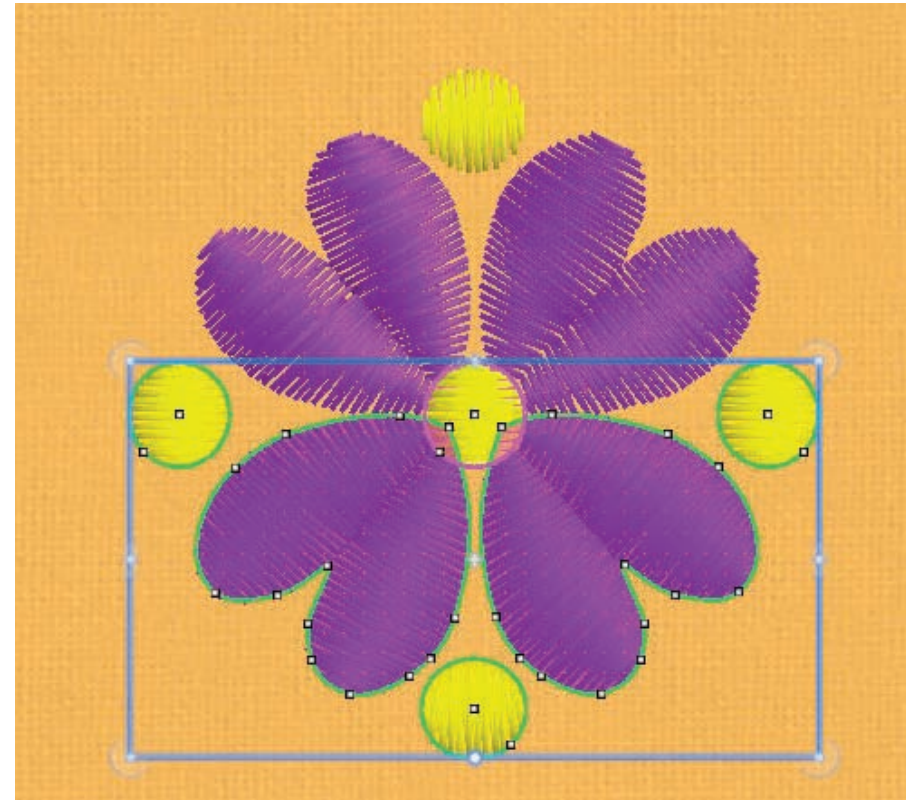
17. Add leaf to loop end.



18. Place small flower on top of loop.



**19.** Create a small flower.

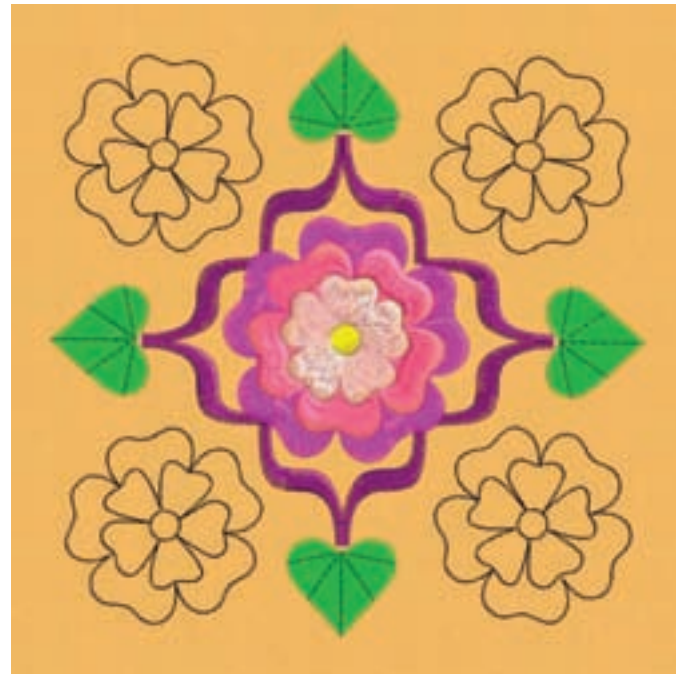


**20.** Add satin circles to create large flower.
